

Celebration day for marine life

ROEBUCK Bay Working Group will this Sunday host "a joyful celebration" of Roebuck Bay's incredible marine life and cultural significance to traditional owners.

Held from midday until 4.30pm, Celebrate The Bay will have a science theme, with many hands-on activities for people to do and learn about the bay's marine life.

Mud dwellers which live in the bay's extensive intertidal mudflats will be on show. Supersized binoculars will be available, for viewing of snubfin dolphins.

Other drawcards will include sea-grass and migratory shorebird displays, a walk to see dinosaur

footprints, a SciTech "marine biology meets pathology" show, and scientists will be there to talk about their research on the bay and careers in science.

Local musician Stephen Pigram will provide entertainment with locally themed songs about pearling, crocodiles and fishing.

For children there will also be games and prizes.
