









Purpose:

To support regeneration of natural capital in the rangelands of WA – soil, water, biodiversity – through good stewardship











Water connects the town to the Bay





What has the Bay got to do with Soil Health and Compost??



What is good soil health?


Healthy soil supports healthy plants by


- 1. Absorbing and holding rain
- 2. Holding, cycling and forming nutrients

Key difference between dirt and soil is LIFE

This life is called the Soil Food Web

- 1. Builds Structure to hold air and water
- 2. Cycles and forms nutrients through the 'poop loop'





Soil Structure = houses built by soil food web








How do you look after your SOIL HEALTH?

5 key tenants from Gabe Brown - youtube him - https://youtu.be/l2MFJ8LNJ9A:

Minimise disturbance – chemical and physical	Both kill your bugs
Armor the soil	mulch / groundcover protect from rain and feed your bugs
Living root in the ground	capture sunlight; feed and protect your bugs
Integrate animals/promote biology	add to the poop loop!! This may mean some manure
Build diversity	use compost to build your SFW; grow lots of different plants







Compost is like a big probiotic hit for your garden

- Adds SFW to your soil!
 - o build structure to hold water (and AIR!)
 - Adds, cycles and makes nutrients available for plants - poop loop
- Plants feed their good soil bugs with sugars via roots in exchange for nutrients
- Dead matter (ie leaves, wood, animals) also feeds back into the cycle
- What actually is compost??
 - o Decomposed organic matter that is full of life!
 - o Like to think of Lego set...








Compost Vs Putrefied Organic Matter



Goldilocks principles to compost





Compost Vs Putrefied Organic Matter



Resource Valuable

Compost

- Aerobic
- No weed seed or pathogens
- Plant nutrient and soil improver
- CO2 only


Putrefied OM

- Anaerobic
- Pathogens
- Alcohols, putric acids; harmful to plants
- Strong GHGs (methane)



These interconnected interactions and feeding relationships (quite literally "who easts who") help determine the types of nutrients present in soil, its depth, and pH, and even the types of plants which can grow.
